STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of Harry J. Bean of Augusta, Kennebec
County, Maine.

*Resolved, That a pension of ten dollars per month be paid
2 to Harry J. Bean of Augusta, Kennebec County, Maine, and
3 to begin January 1, 1915. The same to be paid from the
4 fund appropriated for Military Pensions.*

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

I, George M. Bean of Augusta in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine hereby certify that I am the identical George M. Bean who was a private in Co. B. of the Third Regiment of Maine Infantry Volunteers, and that I am the father of Harry J. Bean of Augusta who on the eighth day of September, A. D. 1912 had his arm torn from its shoulder while working for a livelihood faithfully, and in consequence is now unable to earn a living and comes to me for support which having other children dependent upon me I am unable to give.
