STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in the tributaries to Upper and Lower Wilson Ponds, in the County of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish
2 at any time in any of the tributaries to Upper Wilson pond
3 or in any of the tributaries to Lower Wilson pond, in the
4 county of Piscataquis. Provided, further, that the stream
5 connecting said ponds shall be construed to be a tributary

6 to Lower Wilson pond down as far as low water mark in
7 said Lower Wilson pond at the mouth of said stream.

No person shall have in possession at any time any kind of
9 fish taken in violation of any provision of this act.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine
11 of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars and
12 costs for each offense; and in addition thereto one dollar
13 for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession in
14 violation of any provision of this act.
