AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to the taking of smelts in Bryant's pond and tributaries, in the towns of Woodstock and Greenwood, Oxford county.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

No person or family shall take, catch or kill in any one day  
2 more than eight pounds of smelts in all in Bryant's pond or  
3 in any of its tributaries, which waters are situated in the  
4 towns of Woodstock and Greenwood, in Oxford county, nor  
5 shall any person or family have in possession in any one day  
6 more than eight pounds of smelts in all taken in any of said  
7 waters.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine  
9 of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars and  
10 costs of prosecution for each offense; and in addition there-  
11 to one dollar for each pound of fish taken, caught, killed or  
12 had in possession in violation of any provision of this act.
