#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT Relative to the Hours of Labor of Conductors and Motormen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No street railway company, and no person, firm, corpo-

- 2 ration or other employer operating a street railway, shall
- 3 require any conductor or motorman, to work more than nine
- 4 hours in any day; and if any such conductor or motorman
- 5 shall work nine hours or less in any day, such work shall
- 6 be performed within eleven consecutive hours.
