STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Talmadge, in Washington County, for the Purpose of Building a Road.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) in the year 1917
3 and one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) in the year 1918 for
4 the purpose of laying out and building a road across land
5 of John Dudley lot, so-called, in the town of Talmadge,
6 crossing the Hinckley township, so-called, and across the
7 Indian township to the Houlton road, so-called, providing
8 the town of Talmadge at their next annual town meeting
9 vote to raise the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)

10 for said purpose, to be expended under the supervision of
11 the state highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road would be purely a market road and of material benefit of a deserving farming community and add greatly to their prosperity, necessitating the construction of a new road of more than two miles consisting of about 65 rods in Talmadge, 410 rods on the Hinckley and 250 rods on the Indian townships, all of which will be easily constructed.
