STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section twenty-three of chapter one hundred and twenty-four of the Revised Statutes relating to assaults upon or interference with officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-three of chapter one hundred and twenty-

- 2 four of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by insert-
- 3 ing after the word "warden" in the third line thereof the
- 4 words 'inland fish and game warden,' so that said section,
- 5 as amended, shall read as follows:
- 'Sect. 23. Whoever assaults, intimidates, or in any man-2 ner wilfully obstructs, intimidates or hinders any sheriff,

- 3 coroner, constable, fish warden, inland fish and game war-
- 4 den or police officer while in the lawful discharge of his
- 5 official duties, whether with or without process, shall be
- 6 punished by imprisonment not exceeding one year, or by
- 7 fine not exceeding five hundred dollars.'
