IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT providing for State Paper.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The "Daily Kennebec Journal," a newspaper printed at
2 Augusta, shall be the state paper of this state, in which shall
3 be published all laws and resolves of a public nature; and
4 also all advertisements, notices and orders, required by law
5 to be published in the state paper.
