STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT for the better protection of lobsters and to prevent the transportation thereof out of the State between June first and October first of each year.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. No person or corporation, shall between the

- 2 first day of June and the first day of October in any year,
- 3 carry or transport out of the State, any lobster, or lobsters,
- 4 taken in the waters adjacent to said State and within the
- 5 limits thereof, except such as are canned, and except female
- 6 lobsters with the eggs attached consigned to the United States
- 7 Fish Commission.

Sect. 2. Any person, or the directors or officers of any 2 corporation violating the provisions of this act, shall be 3 punished by fine of not less than two dollars nor more than 4 five dollars for each lobster so unlawfully carried or trans-5 ported out of the State or by imprisonment not less than 6 thirty days or more than ninety days for each offense.
