STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to prevent the shipping of flounders out of the State.

Be it cnacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The shipping or transportation of flounders or (flat fish), 2 in any manner beyond the limits of the state between the 3 first day of October and the fifteenth day of December fol-4 lowing is hereby prohibited under a penalty of ten dollars 5 a barrel for each barrel so shipped or transported.
