STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to trotting purses for agricultural societies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That no agricultural society within this state, giving horse

- 2 races as a part of its annual exhibition, the gross purses of
- 3 any meeting of which amounts to one thousand dollars or
- 4 more, shall receive any stipend from the state unless at
- 5 least one-third of the classes of races advertised and one-
- 6 third of the amount of the purses offered shall be for trot-
- 7 ting classes exclusive of pacers.
