STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize Allan E. Hammond and his associates to erect piers and maintain booms in the St. John river in Hamlin plantation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Allan E. Hammond of Van Buren, Chester C. Whitney of

- 2 Boston, Mass., Frank L. Perry of Woburn, Mass., and
- 3 Henry K. Hyde of Ware, Mass., their associates, successors
- 4 and assigns are hereby authorized to build piers and main-
- 5 tain booms in the Saint John river, in Hamlin plantation,
- 6 from a point opposite the upper or northwesterly line of lot
- 7 numbered three hundred and seventeen, to a point opposite

8 the lower or southeasterly line of lot numbered three hunger of dred and forty-five, for the purpose of holding lumber for 10 purposes of manufacture, but not so as to interfere with the 11 free navigation of the river.
