STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize guardians of insane widows to waive the provisions of their husband's wills.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

A guardian of an insane person shall have the same right 2 that his ward would have if sane to waive the provisions 3 of a will in favor of his ward and to take for his ward's 4 use the same property and rights that such ward would 5 have if sane, with the same right to extension of time within 6 which such waiver may be filed, and all other rights set out 7 in Sections 13 and 14 of Chapter 80 of the Revised Statutes.
