STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section six of Chapter one hundred sixtyfour of the special laws of Nineteen Hundred Fifteen entitled "An Act to provide for the Establishment of a Board of Recreation for the City of Portland."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section six of Chapter one hundred sixty-four of the
Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred fifteen is
hereby amended by striking out the word "ten" in the fourth
and sixth lines and inserting in place thereof the word
'twenty-five' so that said section as amended shall read as
follows:

HOUSE-No. 232.

Sect. 6. For the purposes of carrying out the provisions 2 of this act, the board of park commissioners are hereby 3 ordered, authorized and directed to pay over to the recrea-4 tion commission annually twenty-five (25) percentum of the 5 amount annually appropriated by the city council of the city 6 of Portland for park purposes, said twenty-five (25) per-7 centum to be paid in equal quarterly payments on the first 8 day of January, April, July and October of each year.'
