IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of the military road in the town of Mattawamkeag.

Resolved: That ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) be and 2 hereby is appropriated to re-layout, repair or build military

- 3 road in the town of Mattawamkeag, from the north end of
- 4 Mattawamkeag bridge (State bridge) to north line of said
- 5 town, under the supervision of the state. This expenditure
- 6 should be made in 1917, if possible.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This is the main traveled road from Lincoln to Houlton, carrying the major portion of automobile traffic between these two points. Last season there were several accidents on this road to automobiles, due to the bad condition of the road.
