STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section Twelve of Chapter Forty-three of the Private and Special Laws of Maine, Eighteen Hundred and Ninety-nine, entitled, "An Act to Establish the Rumford Falls Municipal Court."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The word "one" in the fifth line of Section Twelve is 2 hereby amended by changing it to 'two,' so that said section 3 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 12. Costs and fees allowed to parties and attorneys 2 in all actions before said court, in which the debt or damages 3 recovered does not exceed twenty dollars, shall be the same 4 as are allowed in actions before trial justices, except that 5 the plaintiff if he prevail shall be allowed two dollars for 6 his writ, and the defendant if he prevail one dollar for his 7 pleadings; but in cases where the damages do exceed 8 twenty dollars, the fees and costs shall be the same as in 9 the supreme judicial court.'
