STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT in Relation to Supplying Electric Current at Reduced Rates for Educational Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: All individual, firms or corporations supplying electric 2 current to the public for light or power, are hereby author-3 ized to supply electric current for use in public schools in 4 the state of Maine or for use in academies receiving state 5 aid at reduced rates subject to approval of the public utilities 6 commission.
