# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE in favor of Amanda H. Loud, of Randolph.

Resolved, That the sum of ten dollars per month be paid 2 to Amanda H. Loud of Randolph, widow of a veteran of 3 the Civil War, payable quarterly from the fund apportationed for military pensions, beginning January first, nine-5 teen hundred seventeen, and continuing until otherwise or-6 dered.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Amanda H. Loud, of Randolph, widow of the late John L. Flagg, who enlisted as a private in the Civil War in 1861, was wounded in the battle of Gettysburg, receiving an honorable discharge from the service in 1864, he entered the Charlestown Navy Yard in the service of the Government, where he was accidentally killed.

Mrs. Amanda H. Loud has never been able to procure a United States pension.

She had two brothers in the Civil War, and one son in the Spanish War.
