# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section One of Chapter Seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to Wills.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter seventy-nine of the Revised Stat-

- 2 utes is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "twen-
- 3 ty-one years" in the second line, the words 'and a married
- 4 woman or widow of any age,' so that said section, as
- 5 amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 1. A person of sound mind, and of the age of

- 2 twenty-one years, and a married woman or widow of any
- 3 age, may dispose of his real and personal estate by will,

4 in writing signed by him, or by some person for him at his 5 request, and in his presence, and subscribed in his presence 6 by three credible attesting witnesses, not beneficially inter-7 ested under said will.'

(The purpose of the above proposed amendment is to make said section conform to and be consistent with the provisions of Section I of Chapter 66 of the Revised Statutes, relating to the rights of married women.)
