### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to the digging of clams within the limits of the towns of Newcastle and Damariscotta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person not a resi2 dent of the towns of Newcastle and Damariscotta, in the
3 county of Lincoln, to dig for clams within the limits of
4 said towns. This section shall not interfere with any law
5 relating to taking shell fish for bait by fishermen.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of section one of 2 this act shall for each offense be punished by a fine of not 3 more than ten dollars, or by imprisonment for not more 4 than thirty days.
