STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT Additional to Chapter 51 of the Private and Special Laws of 1907, Relating to the Pollution of the Waters of North or Varnum's Pond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: If any person shall bathe in the waters of said North or 2 Varnum's Pond so long as the waters of the same are used 3 for the purpose of supplying the water for domestic use, 4 in any town or village, he shall be fined not exceeding twenty 5 dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding six months.
