STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to extend the charter of the North Bridgeon Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the North Bridgton

Village Corporation, which were granted by chapter one

hundred thirty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of

nineteen hundred fifteen, are hereby extended for two years

additional; and the persons named in said act, their asso
ciates and successors, shall have the rights, powers and privi
leges that were granted to them by said act to be by them

exercised as therein set forth, and such further time of two

9 years for their acceptance of the charter of said corporation 10 as provided by section eight of said act, is hereby granted.
