## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 30, Section 55 of the Revised Statutes of 1916, relating to the Insurance Commissioner Investigating Fires.

Bc it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 30, Section 55, Revised Statutes of 1916, is hereby 2 amended by striking out all of said section after the word 3 "exceed" in the fifth line and before the word "and" in the 4 ninth line of said section and insert in place therefor the 5 words 'fifteen hundred dollars' so that said section as 6 amended shall read as follows:

## HOUSE-No. 395.

'Sect. 55. The insurance commissioner may employ such 2 clerks and assistants, provide such blanks and incur such ex-3 pense, as may be necessary to carry out his duties in investi-4 gating or causing to be investigated the origin of fires and 5 the inspection of buildings and property, not to exceed fif-6 teen hundred dollars and all bills and expenses incurred shall 7 be audited by the state auditor.'
