STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 9, Section 33, of the Revised
Statutes of 1916, relating to the taxation of owners of parlor
cars.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 9, Section 33, of the Revised Statutes of 1916,
2 is hereby amended by striking out the words "from business
3 done wholly in" in line six of said section and inserting in
4 place therefor the words 'collected within,' so that said
5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Every corporation or person owning or operating parlor

2 or other cars for which extra compensation is charged for
3 riding therein over any of the railroads of the state shall
4 annually on the first day of September, pay to the treasurer
5 of state for the use of the state an annual excise tax for
6 the privilege of exercising its franchises in the state, equal
7 to six per cent of its or his gross receipts collected within
8 the state, for the year ending June thirtieth next preceding.'
