# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter sixty-four of the Revised Statutes relating to marriage by insane or feebleminded persons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter sixty-four of the Revised Statutes

- $\boldsymbol{2}$  is hereby amended by inserting after the word "insane" and
- 3 before the word "person" the words 'or feeble-minded,' so
- 4 that said section as amended shall read as follows:
- 'Sect. 2. No insane or feeble-minded person or idiot is 2 capable of contracting marriage.'
