STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 29 of Chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes relating to relief of state paupers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 29 of Chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes is amend-

- 2 ed by adding thereto the words 'but towns failing to so file
- 3 bills for support of state paupers on account of unavoidable
- 4 accident, mistake or delay may be reimbursed as provided
- 5 in Section 28,' so that said section as amended shall read 6 as follows:

'Sect. 29. All bills for support of state paupers shall be

2 filed with the governor and council within three months 3 after the same are contracted, and no such bills shall be 4 allowed unless they are so filed within thirty days after the 5 thirty-first day of December of the year in which they are 6 contracted, but towns failing to so file bills for support of 7 state paupers on account of unavoidable accident, mistake 8 or delay may be reimbursed as provided in Section 28.'
