### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section six, Paragraph four, Chapter fifty of the Revised Statutes of Maine, for Nineteen Hundred Sixteen, relating to compensation for personal injuries for employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section Six, Paragraph four, of Chapter fifty of the Re-2 vised Statutes of Nineteen Hundred Sixteen is hereby 3 amended by the addition of the following paragraph:

'Any town or city may, in lieu of the compensation and 2 insurance provided by this act, continue any member of the

- 3 fire department in said town, who may have been injured
- 4 in the course of his duties, on the payroll at full pay, if such
- 5 full pay exceeds the maximum compensation provided for
- 6 employees under this act.'
