STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The roof of the Armory building at Portland is very much out of repair, causing several bad leaks that threaten serious damage to the valuable fire control apparatus installed by the Federal Government at an expense of over seventy-five thousand (\$75,000) dollars for the use of the National Guard and for which the State of Maine is responsible for safe-keeping and proper care. The fact that the regular appropriation for armory rents is inadequate to take care of any but minor repairs and the urgent necessity for immediate attention to this matter for the protection of valuable public property makes this special appropriation necessary. The amount asked for is based on the careful estimates of expert roofers.
