IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE Reimbursing the City of Auburn for Money Expended for the Support of Certain State Paupers.

Resolved, That the sum of seven hundred eighty-six dol-2 lars and eighty-two cents be, and hereby is, appropriated 3 to be paid to the city of Auburn, to reimburse said city for 4 the amount expended for the support of Joseph Dulac and 5 George J. Schlag, state paupers. •

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The city of Auburn expended \$716.27 from June, 1912, to Jan. 1, 1916, for the support of Joseph Dulac, who has no pauper settlement in the state.

The city of Auburn also expended \$70.55 from Aug. 1 to Dec. 1, 1914, for the support of George J. Schlag, who likewise has no pauper settlement in the state.

Affidavits in both cases, giving full particulars as to settlement, etc., are on file with the Governor and Council.
