STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to prevent officers and employees of banking institutions from making copies of records.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Any officer or employee of any savings bank, institution for 2 savings, trust company, loan company, or loan and building 3 association, making copies of any of the books, papers, rec-4 ords or documents belonging to or in the custody of any of 5 the before named institutions, either for his own use or for 6 the use of any other person other than in the ordinary and 7 regular course of his duties as such officer or employee, shall 8 be subject to a penalty of a fine not exceeding five hundred 9 dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding one year or by both 10 such fine and imprisonment.
