STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT additional to Chapter fifty-three of the Revised Stattutes of 1916 relating to the payment of benefits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No corporation organized or authorized under the laws of
this State to transact life insurance or to pay benefits shall
provide in any policy, certificate, contract, or agreement issued or made by it, for the payment of any insurance, indemnity, or benefit, in services, goods, wares, or merchandise of any kind.
