STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT in Addition to Section Thirteen of Chapter Fourteen, Revised Statutes, Relating to Adoptions in the Penobscot Tribe.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter fourteen of the revised statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sentence,
- 3 'but no person hereafter adopted into the tribe shall be
- + eligible to hold the office of governor, lieutenant-governor, or
- 5 representative of said tribe,' so that said section as amended
- 6 shall read as follows:

'Whenever said tribal committee shall vote to adopt any

2 person into said tribe, a certificate of such vote of adoption

3 shall be signed by the person presiding at the meeting, and 4 said certificate shall be filed with the agent of said tribe; and 5 said adopted person shall thereafter be deemed and accepted 6 to be a member of said tribe for all intents and purposes, 7 and shall be enrolled as such upon the list of its members. 8 But no person hereafter adopted into the tribe shall be 9 eligible to hold the office of governor, lieutenant-governor, or 10 representative of said tribe.'
