STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Eighty-two of Chapter Four of the Revised Statutes Relating to Instruction of Librarians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eighty two of chapter four of the revised statutes 2 is hereby amended by inserting before the word "The" in the

- 3 first line thereof the words 'On application to the state lib-
- 4 rarian or the Maine library commission,' and by inserting
- 5 after the words "state library" in the second line thereof,
- 6 the words 'or at their own library,' so that said section as
- 7 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 82. On application to the state librarian or the

- 2 Maine library commission, the librarian or trustees of any
- 3 free public library may receive instruction at the state library
- 4 or at their own library, in cataloguing, and any other mat-
- 5 ters pertaining to the maintenance or administration of the
- 6 library.'
