IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of Fred R. Smith, of Pittsfield, for Expenses incurred as a Member of the Hospital trustees in Investigating Conditions at the Augusta State Hospital in 1913.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of Two Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars and Five Cents, 3 (\$237.05) to be paid to Fred R. Smith of Pittsfield, "for ex-4 penses incurred by him as a member of the Hospital Trus-5 tees in investigating conditions at the Augusta State Hos-6 pital, and in presenting charges before the Governor and 7 Council."
