STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys Received by the Treasurer of State and Credited by him to the Public Administrator's Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-one, of chapter sixty-eight, of the Revised

- 2 Statutes, is hereby amended by adding to said section the
- 3 following words, 'and such principal is hereby appropriated
- 4 to pay such lawful claims;' so that as amended said section
- 5 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 31. When there is, in the hands of such public ad-2 ministrator, an amount of money, more than is necessary for 3 the payment of the deceased's debts and for other purposes 4 of administration, he shall be required by the judge to de-5 posit it with the treasurer of state, who shall receive it; the 6 state shall be responsible for the principal thereof, for the 7 benefit of those who may lawfully claim it; and the governor 8 and council, on application and proof, may order the treas-9 urer to pay it over, and such principal is hereby appropriated 10 to pay such lawful claims.'
