STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE making appropriation to support the Bureau of Horticulture for years 1917 and 1918.

Resolved, That for the purpose of carrying into effect all 2 provisions of the law now in force, or as the same may be 3 amended, and added to, relative to the Bureau of Horticul-4 ture, there be, and hereby is, appropriated out of any mon-5 eys in the treasury the sum of five thousand dollars for 6 the year one thousand nine hundred seventeen and the sum 7 of five thousand for the year one thousand nine hundred 8 and eighteen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The duties of the Bureau of Horticulture consist of the inspection of nurseries, inspection of orchard and shade trees, inspection of nursery stock coming into the State from outside the State, demonstrations in various phases of orchard work, lecture work, publishing reports, short articles and bulletins along the lines of horticulture, granting of licenses for selling nursery stock, and the granting of certificates of inspection of nurseries in the State.

This appropriation is the same in amount and for the same purpose as that made in previous years.
