STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 117, Section 18, of the Revised Statutes of 1916 relating to the Insurance Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 117, Section 18, of the Revised Statutes of 1916,

- 2 is amended by adding after the word "dollars" in the second
- 3 line thereof, the words 'in full payment for all services, both
- 4 as insurance commissioner and as a member of the Industrial
- 5 Accident Commission' so that, said section, as amended,
- 6 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 18. The insurance commissioner shall receive an 2 annual salary of two thousand five hundred dollars in full

3 payment for all services, both as insurance commissioner

4 and as a member of the Industrial Accident Commission.

'The deputy insurance commissioner shall receive an an-2 nual salary of eighteen hundred dollars.

'The Governor and Council may allow such reasonable 2 sums for postage, clerk hire, and actual expenses incurred in 3 the proper enforcement of the laws relating to insurance 4 as they deem proper.'
