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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to repeal Section twelve of Chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and sixteen relating to intention to defraud in lumbering operations and commonly known as the Peonage Law.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section twelve of Chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of  
2 the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and sixteen entitled  
3 "Intention to Defraud in Lumbering Operations 1907 c. 7,"  
4 is hereby repealed.
