STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to repeal Section twelve of Chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and sixteen relating to intention to defraud in lumbering operations and commonly known as the Peonage Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twelve of Chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of

the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and sixteen entitled

"Intention to Defraud in Lumbering Operations 1907 c. 7,"

is hereby repealed.
