STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to establish a county insurance agent for and within the county of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The county treasurer of Cumberland county is hereby cre-2 ated the insurance agent of said county, and he shall have 3 full charge of insuring all the county buildings and their 4 contents, and he shall pay the premium from the county 5 treasury.
