STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relative to the construction of extensions and branches by the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company, its suc-2 cessors and assigns are hereby authorized and empowered 3 to locate, construct, maintain and operate extensions and 4 branches of the lines of railroad now or hereafter owned, 5 leased, constructed or operated by it, the locations of which 6 before construction thereof is commenced shall have been

7 approved by the Public Utilities Commission after petition

/ approved by the Fubic Othices Commission after petition

8 and public hearing.
