### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter 199 of the Private and Special Laws of 1889, regulating Caucuses in the City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred ninety-nine of the

- 2 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-nine
- 3 is hereby amended by striking out in the third line thereof,
- 4 the words "at which its gubernatorial candidate may be
- 5 chosen," so that said section as amended shall read as fol-
- 6 lows:

'Section 1. Any political party in the city of Biddeford en-2 titled to choose delegates to the state convention of such par-3 ty, shall at the caucus named to choose such delegates to said 4 state convention, elect its city committee, and committees 5 chosen at other times shall have no power or authority for 6 calling any ward or city caucuses. The committee so chosen 7 shall hold office for term of two years from the first day of 8 January following their election, except as herein provided.'
