IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

AN ACT to prohibit the Bar Harbor and Union River Power Company from charging discriminatory rates in the sale of electric current.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Bar Harbor and Union River Power Company is
