STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Rockland, South Thomaston and St. George Railway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Rockland, South Thomaston & St. George Railway, which were granted to it by Chapter two hundred and five of the Private and Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred and thirteen, and extended by Chapter one hundred and sixty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred and fifteen, are hereby extended for two years additional; and

8 said Corporation shall have the rights, powers and privileges,
9 that were granted to it by said Act, to be exercised by it for
10 the same purposes as specified in said Act.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal or
2 shall be construed as repealing the whole or any part of any
3 existing statute. And all the rights and duties herein men-
4 tioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance with
5 all the applicable provisions of Chapter one hundred and
6 twenty-nine of the Public Laws of the State of Maine for
7 the year nineteen hundred and thirteen, as from time to time
8 amended.
