RESOLVE Providing a State Pension for Stephen F. Flood.

---

*Resolved,* That there be paid to Stephen F. Flood of St.  
2 George, in the county of Knox, the sum of ten dollars per  
3 month, payable quarterly from the fund appropriated for  
4 military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred  
5 seventeen, and continuing during the pleasure of the Legis-  
6 lature and until otherwise ordered.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Stephen F. Flood lives in a small cottage on Rackliffe Island in St. George and has a wife and a large family. He is past the age of hard labor and very feeble and very poor. He served in the U. S. Navy about 15 years and has an honorable discharge and has just received a pension at the rate of \$10 per month which is practically his sole income. From what he can earn and what he receives from the United States he is unable to support himself and family.
