STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT additional to Chapter 52 of the Revised Statutes of 1916 with reference to limitation of actions to recover money paid on forged signatures.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No denial of the signature on any order drawn on a sav-2 ings bank, institution for savings or trust company, or on 3 any receipt for payment by said bank, institution for sav-4 ings or trust company on account of any deposit, shall avail 5 after five years from the time of payment thereof; but 6 such payment shall be a complete defense to any action for

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7 the recovery of the money so paid, wherein service is made8 upon said bank, institution for savings or trust company,9 after the expiration of said period of five years.
