STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize persons to vote in cities, towns and plantations from which they have changed their residences.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. When any person who has complied with the

- 2 provisions of section two, of chapter five of the Revised
- 3 Statutes of nineteen hundred sixteen, desires to change his
- 4 residence to another city, town or plantation within the state,
- 5 he may notify the city clerk, or the town clerk, as the case
- 6 may be, of the city, town or plantation which he desires to
- 7 leave, of his intention to change his residence. The city

8 clerk or town clerk, as the case may be, of the city, town or 9 plantation which said person desires to leave, shall thereupon 10 enter in a book for that purpose the name and residence of II the person, as they appear on the check list of the said city, 12 town or plantation, the date of the notification that said 13 person intends to change his residence, the name of the city, 14 town or plantation within the state to which said person in-15 tends to change his residence; and thereafter said person 16 shall be allowed to vote in said city, town or plantation which 17 he desires to leave, until after the expiration of three months 18 from the date of the filing of his said intention with the said 19 city or town clerk, and the board of selectmen or board of 20 registration, as the case may be, of the said city, town or 21 plantation which said person desires to leave, shall not strike 22 from the voting lists of which they have the custody, the 23 name of the said person, until after the expiration of three 24 months from the time when the said person's intention was 25 filed with the said city or town clerk. Provided also, that 26 said person's name shall not be added to the voting lists of 27 the city, town or plantation of his new residence until after 28 the expiration of three months from the time when he shall 29 have voted in the city, town or plantation of his old 30 residence.

Sect. 2. All fines and penalties providing for the violation 2 of the provisions of chapter five of the revised statutes of 3 nineteen hundred sixteen shall be applicable so far as is 4 possible to violations of this act.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith 2 are hereby repealed.
