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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to provide for the payment of traveling expenses of registers of probate when attending terms of court in places other than county seat.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Registers of Probate, in the several counties, shall receive their actual traveling expenses from the treasurers of the county, when obliged to attend terms of court in places other than the county seat.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
