STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE in favor of the Machias Electric Light Company
in payment for current furnished the Washington State Nor-
mal School.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of two hundred ninety-one dollars and thirty cents in
3 favor of the Machias Electric Light Company of Machias
4 in payment for current furnished the Washington State
5 Normal School from January first, nineteen hundred six-
6 teen, to December first, nineteen hundred sixteen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

On account of an error in the reading of the electric meter the charge for each month from January, nineteen hundred sixteen, to November, nineteen hundred sixteen, inclusive, was for only one-tenth the amount of current actually consumed. This resolve is to pay the balance due for the above months.
