STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to define and amend the laws in regard to tuition.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Towns or cities admitting to their schools persons of school 2 age who are temporary residents, or who are employed in 3 said city or town, shall be recompensed to the same extent 4 from the school funds of the state as if said persons were 5 enrolled in manual training or night school.

All acts or portions of acts inconsistent with the foregoing 2 are hereby repealed.
