RESOLVE in favor of L. E. Bradstreet & Sons Company for
the balance due on the Farmington State Normal School
dormitory construction.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor
2 of L. E. Bradstreet & Sons Company of Hallowell the sum
3 of one hundred thirteen dollars and fifty cents in payment
4 of work performed in the construction of the Farmington
5 State Normal School dormitory in nineteen hundred four-
6 teen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The amount of two hundred dollars was withheld from the contract of L. E. Bradstreet & Sons Company for construction of the Farmington State Normal School dormitory in nineteen hundred fourteen on account of unfinished work. An allowance of eighty-six dollars and fifty cents was made on account of hardware fixtures and the remainder, one hundred thirteen dollars and fifty cents, is to pay the balance for which no appropriation was available when the work was completed.
